

NEW SCHOOL STRUCTURE

DUTIES OF THE HEAD OF DEPARTMENT

The Head of an academic department in a School will report to the Head of School and will be part of the School's senior management team.

The duties of the Head of Department will be combined with those of an academic member of faculty and could also be combined with those of a Director within the School.

The Head of School will be responsible for academic members of the School. However, the Head of School may delegate some line management activities to the Head of Department although the Head of School will retain accountability to the University for the
